## WHAT IS THE MASSACHUSETTS CEMETERY ASSOCIATION?

The Massachusetts Cemetery Association was founded in 1944 and incorporated in 1970.

The Massachusetts Cemetery Association continually strives to meet the following objectives:

- To create and maintain high ethical standards in the conduct of cemetery administration.
- To secure the advantages to be obtained by mutual cooperation.
- To provide for the proper care and maintenance of cemeteries, mausoleums, and columbarium so that they will remain permanent places of beauty.
- To distribute information relating to the operations of cemeteries, mausoleums and columbaria.

## WHAT IS THE FUNCTION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS CEMETERY ASSOCIATION?

The Massachusetts Cemetery Association represents cemetery members throughout the Commonwealth. Its members consist of municipal, religious, non-secular, non-profit and private cemeteries.
